

3-D Eye Tricks

Creative Station:



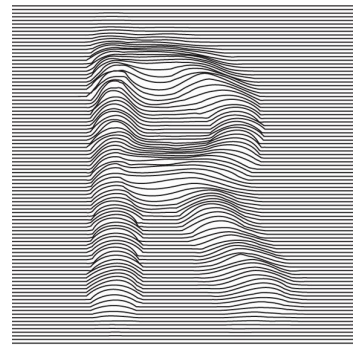
Using curves and straight lines when designing a piece of artwork can trick the viewer's eyes and make a picture look like it is 3-D!

Trace an object lightly on a piece of paper with a pencil.

Draw straight lines on the paper around the image. Then draw lines which curve on the object. It is important to make sure your curved and straight lines match up.

Note: The distance between lines can vary, they do not need to be an exact distance apart.

Select your color palate using color pencils, crayons, or markers. Then choose the pattern you will use to fill in the white space between each line.



Have fun with your design!

Exploration challenge: Try multiple designs, use contrasting colors, try a design with the object having a different pattern from the background.
